Eosinophilic Esophagitis: Practical Diagnosis and Management of Pediatric Patients with EoE

Presented by Mirna Chehade, MD, MPH

Dr. Chehade will review long-term nutritional strategies and medical management for pediatric patients with Eosinophilic Esophagitis (EoE). She will specifically discuss the immunopathogenesis of EoE; identify EoE clinical manifestations in pediatric patients; distinguish EoE from other causes with similar symptoms, such as gastroesophageal reflux disease; review essential diagnosis criteria and histological features; and examine current standard of care and clinical recommendations.
